What types of programs will my donation benefit?

Donations to For Every Life on the Line through IU Health Foundation will directly support IU Health's statewide trauma and critical care programs. These programs might include, but are not limited to, expansions to the IU Health Lifeline fleet, injury prevention education & outreach, critical equipment and training programs, IU Health trauma and neurological trauma services, the Emergency Clothing Program, and so much more.

Will I receive a receipt for my donation?

When will I receive information about early access to volunteer opportunities?

You will receive detailed instructions on how to register as a Rev volunteer and sign up for early access shifts on 2/18/2026. Early access volunteer opportunities will be available 2/25/2026. Questions can be sent to revvolunteers@iuhealth.org.

Tickets are sold out. Is there a way to get tickets through this campaign?

Once public ticket sales are complete, the first 45 individuals who donate at the Trauma Ally Tier (\$250-\$499) will receive exclusive access to purchase two **Premiere tickets** to Rev Indy 2026 at a discount of \$100 off the pair (\$250/ticket).

These tickets are limited and will be offered to the ticket waitlist and public on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once all available tickets are purchased, this perk is no longer available at this tier. Tickets must be purchased within the purchase window outlined in the ticket link email.
